This scholarship is for a female member of the Women Soaring Pilots Association and SSA (if living in the U.S.). Applicants must have a Commercial Pilot Certificate for Gliders and be working toward an Instructor Rating in gliders. Preference will be given to applicants who have already taken the FAA Knowledge Test ("Fundamentals of Instruction" or a comparable test in their country).

The scholarship funds (\$1500) can be used to help pay for ground and flight instruction, fees for required written exams and flight exam and for membership in a glider club if such membership results in a reduction in fees for instruction and flight time. The applicant is expected to obtain the CFG rating within one year of receiving the scholarship.

The following information must be provided along with this application form:

1. Essay of 500 words or less explaining your goals and previous experiences as they relate to gliders and how this scholarship will help you meet your goals.
2. Historical outline of your glider training and flights to show what you have already accomplished and in what time period. (Do not copy your entire log book, but do show the most recent entries that include your total time).
3. Copy of your pilot certificate (front and back)
4. Photo of you, preferably with a glider, no sun glasses
5. Name and address of the gliderport where you plan to take your training.
6. Your plans to instruct in gliders (such as a letter from your glider club or a commercial glider operator that there is an opportunity for you to work as an instructor)
