The scholarship is open to women <u>over the age of 25</u> to help pay for lessons toward a Private Glider Certificate or an add-on glider rating. Applicants who are student pilots must have soloed in a glider and have taken and passed the required FAA Knowledge Test (or equivalent for their country). These requirements are waived if the applicant already has an ASEL or higher license and is seeking an add-on glider rating. Membership in WSPA is required. If living and flying in the US, SSA membership is also required. The scholarship is for \$1500 and may be used at any glider training facility.

Applicants may apply for only one scholarship per year. Applications must include the following:

- 1. An essay of 500 words or less explaining your goals and previous experiences as they relate to gliders and how this scholarship will help you meet your goals.
- 2. A photo, preferably with an aircraft, no sunglasses, please.
- 3. A copy of your pilot certificate (front and back) (student or higher).
- 4. If a student glider pilot, a copy of logbook entries that include solo flight(s).
- 5. If a student glider pilot, evidence that you have passed the FAA Knowledge Test.
- 6. The name and address of the glider port where you plan to take your training.
- 7. A letter of recommendation from someone familiar with your glider experiences.
